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Energy Market Update Con Edison Electric Rate Hikes: Approved

On Wednesday, March 19, 2007, the New York Public Service Commission (PSC) approved a \$425 million increase in rates for Con Edison. The increase represented just ~35% of Con Edison's \$1.207 billion request from last spring.

As a result of the increase, commercial and industrial customers will see:

- An increase of T&D rates of ~8-10%

The rate hike will become effective April 1, 2008 for Con Edison customers in New York City and Westchester County.

The increase affects transmissions and delivery charges only (not electricity supply). There is the possibility of another increase next spring.

Please take this information into consideration during your budgeting process. For current MCE EnergyTrack (ETS) subscribers, these rate hikes will be incorporated into the Budget Module of the web-based MCE EnergyTrack system.
